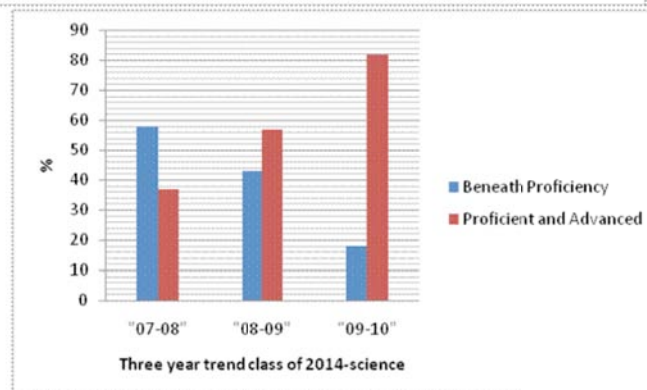
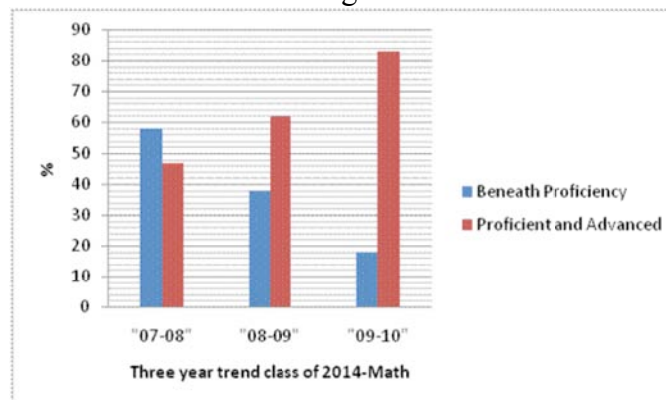
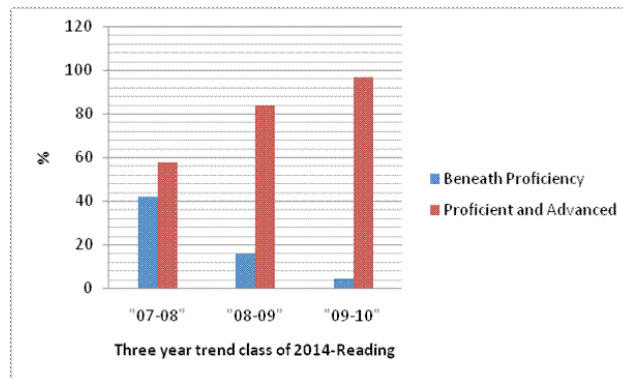




AIMS FACTS

- ☒ **AYP:** Only 29 public high schools in the state of New Mexico made AYP. AIMS was one of them. In fact, AIMS has always made AYP through out the length of the charter..
- ☒ **Our Scores:** The Albuquerque Institute for Mathematics and Science @UNM had the highest scores in the state in Reading, Math and Science in New Mexico (84.4%, 87.16% and 90% respectively). By the 11th grade, AIMS students are 100% proficient in reading, math and science.
- ☒ **Our students don't necessarily come to the school proficient!:** The first sixth grade class was enrolled in 2007, and they came to us from all over the city. When those kids first tested, they were close to 39% proficiency in math! However, these kiddos' made incredible progress over the past few years with some of the initiatives we introduced, including mandatory tutoring,. Those students went from 39% proficient and advanced to over 85 % proficient and advanced. We saw the same trends in science and reading.





- ☒ **We have narrowed and in some cases eliminated the “achievement gap”:**
 Over a three year period, we also saw the achievement gap between our Hispanic and Caucasian students diminish, with gains of 38% and 29% in reading and math achievement. Today, with 290 students, this gap has narrowed even more with virtually no difference detected between Hispanic and Caucasian subgroups.
- ☒ **Graduation rate is 93.3%**, with graduates on the average earning 60 credit hours at the University of New Mexico. **In fact, one of our first graduates is graduating from UNM with a double science major after only two years at UNM.**
- ☒ **Credo Study:** According to the Credo Study, AIMS is one of only six charter schools in the state that out performs the local educational agencies (LEA’s)
- ☒ **We are a free public high school.** It costs parents nothing for their children to attend.
- ☒ **We are diverse:** 46% Hispanic, 41% Caucasian, 13% Asian
- ☒ **Our wait list is roughly double our enrollment.** Next year we will only be able to accept new sixth graders.
- ☒ **We are out of space:** Although we are not at capacity according to the Charter (360) we are in terms of space (290). Although we are in a public building (as required by legislation), there is no room to expand currently.
- ☒ **80% of our students are identified a “college ready” by the 8th grade:** As measured by ACT.
- ☒ **None of our graduates have had to enroll in remedial classes at the post secondary level.**
- ☒ **All of our graduates are enrolled in post secondary institutions, with the majority staying in New Mexico.**
- ☒ **ALL AIMS high school students take AP classes**
- ☒ **How does our progress compare with the local school district?**
